September 2, 2011, Medjugorje


„Dear children!

TIME OF PRAYER AND SILENCE

In his infinite love, God created the world, all creatures. As the crown of creation, as the utmost of his love, God created man. He wanted man to be a co-creator of God's beautiful deeds. The Bible also confirms this: *"The LORD God formed out of the ground various wild animals and various birds of the air, and he brought them to the man to see what he would call them; whatever the man called each of them would be its name. The man gave names to all the cattle, all the birds of the air, and all the wild animals."* (Gen. 2:19 - 20). God created man who gave names to the creatures. In



the beginning, everything was harmonic, filled with peace, order and mutual trust. And then, as the Book of Wisdom tells us, *"By the envy of the devil, death entered the world"* (Wis 2:24).

Man is created according to the God's image and he is dependent on his Creator.

Our first parents, tempted by the devil, abused their freedom and disobeyed God's commandment. Since then, every sin is disobedience to God and lacks trust in his goodness.

The only 'trespass' of God is in that He created everything in freedom and love. And He wants man, in freedom and love, to always come back to him and to trust and obey His word and commandments. Since the time when God created man, He has never forgotten nor left him. Throughout the entire history of salvation we see how God comes first and seeks man. DEAR FRIENDS OF THE QUEEN OF PEACE!

In the words of Our Lady we have often heard the close motherly call, "*... Dear children, I need you, without you I can do nothing... Each one of you is important ... Help me to help you. Your prayers are necessary to me so that God may be glorified through all of you... Dear children, I pray for you, obey and live the Mother's invitation, because only out of love am I calling you in order that I might help you.... I need hearts ready for immeasurable love... My children, you be my apostles, be my river of love....*"

Mary wants us to pray for her intentions. Her intentions are certainly what matters and are good for all humanity - all her children. Mother knows what is best for her children, the most important in this very mo-

ment. We do not know this. In the message of September 25, 1991 Our Lady teaches us -"*I beseech all of you to offer prayers and sacrifices for my intentions so I can present them to God for what is most necessary. Forget your desires, dear children, and pray for what God desires, and not for what you desire.*"

Mary is an obedient daughter of the Father, the Bride of the Holy Spirit, the Mother of Jesus. She knows the action of the Holy Trinity. She teaches us to give ourselves to the blow of the Holy Spirit, just as the Apostle Paul teaches us in his Letter to Romans 8:26-27: "*The Spirit too comes to the aid of our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit itself intercedes with inexpressible groaning. And the one who*

searches hearts knows what is the intention of the Spirit, because it intercedes for the holy ones according to God's will."

Our Lord, through the apparitions of Our Lady began in Medjugorje, began a great renewal of the world. This is testified by many testimonies of those who have made themselves totally available to her. She began with the visionaries, then with the parish of Medjugorje, and now there are millions of pilgrims from around the world. The one who responds to her messages and wants to walk with Mary on the way of holiness, Our Lady will lead him into the depths of the spiritual life. According to the testimony of the visionaries, Our Lady wants this through prayer groups, which will realize the plans God has entrusted to her in this time. When Our Lady appeared in Fatima, Portugal, in 1917 to three children and called them to sacrifice themselves a lot for the conversion of sinners, the children decided to give Our Lady their daily sacrifices and self-renouncing for her intentions. One of them, Sr. Lucy recalls in her memoirs her friends, blessed Jacinta and Francis, renounced things they liked, out of their love to Our Lady and for the conversion of sinners. They renounced dancing, entertainment, food, various tidbits and water in the time of extreme heat. They were able to do everything for Our Lady.

Let us pray and fast in this time. Let us also give Our Lady our little renunciations for her intentions. Let us be strong and resolute in living her messages.

Let us pray: Almighty God, you are our strength, our resoluteness; with you we can do anything. Thank you for all the lessons in love, which you give us through the messages of the Queen of Peace. In her Immaculate Heart we pray, touch with the power of your love, the hearts of those who do not want to hear nor accept your call to conversion through her. Together with Our Lady, we ask you, almighty God, that the force of evil that wants to destroy your plans for peace be destroyed. Mary, today anew we say "Totus Tu-tus". We make ourselves totally available to you. Protect us, Mother. We give our 'yes' to you. We want to pray for accomplishment of your plans with us and through us. Amen.



...Dear children, help my Immaculate Heart to triumph in the sinful world. I beseech all of you to offer prayers and sacrifices for my intentions so I can present them to God for what is most necessary. Forget your desires, dear children, and pray for what God desires, and not for what you desire... (September 25, 1991)

...In a special way I call you all to pray for my intentions so that, through your prayers, you may stop Satan's plan over this world, which is further from God every day, and which puts itself in the place of God and is destroying everything that is beautiful and good in the souls of each of you. Therefore, little children, arm yourselves with prayer and fasting so that you may be conscious of how much God loves you, and carry out God's will... (Octóber 25, 2008)

...I invite you to decide to pray for my intentions. Dear children, offer novenas, making sacrifices wherein you feel the most bound. I want your life to be bound to me... (July 25, 1993)

Greatest sacrifice is love

“Dear children! I wish to thank you for all the sacrifices and I invite you to the greatest sacrifice, the sacrifice of love. Without love, you are not able to accept either me or my Son. Without love, you cannot give an account of your experiences to others. Therefore, dear children, I call you to begin to live love within yourselves. Thank you for having responded to my call.” (March 27, 1986)

The Lent is a call to life through a new covenant, the covenant of love. On March 13th, just two weeks previously, Our Lady recommended that we do everything with love and that we help with love. She encouraged all in the beginning of Lent to perform sacrifices, penances and fasting with love, so that they would have their full value. In this message, the surprise words are “the greatest sacrifice is love”. Obviously, it is necessary to change our way of thinking in order to comprehend this message. Sacrifice is always hard for us. When we die to ourselves and to our own wants, and so give more of ourselves to others and to God, it can be something unpleasant. For, as much as the word ‘sacrifice’ seems unpleasant in our everyday language, every time we hear that someone is sacrificing himself for us, we feel a sense of gratitude, love, joy and security. The sacrifices of others for us open us up to the value of life. It is a testament of love for us.

How can love be the greatest sacrifice, when love makes a person happy, makes our suffering easy and makes every life happy? Somewhere at the end of our contemplations and feelings, at our conclu-

sions and understanding, sacrifice becomes love, and love becomes sacrifice. One who does not sacrifice, does not grow in love. When a person grows in love, sacrifice becomes an expression of greatest love; and greatest love leads to sacrifice.

Our Lady lived with Jesus. She is His mother and teacher. She lived with Him, learning with Him the greatest sacrifice, the sacrifice of love. As She cannot accept Jesus without love, so She knows that we could not accept Jesus without grace and love. Our experience, our testimony to love, becomes a light, a way and a truth to others. To begin to renew love within ourselves means to transform everything into a sacrifice of love. Sacrifice leads us out of sin and death and so gives us life.

Beloved, let us love one another, because love is God; everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God. Whoever is without love, does not know God, for God is love. In this way, the love of God was revealed to us: God sent His only Son into the world so that we might have life through Him. In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as expiation for our sins. (1 Jn 4:7-10)

THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Illness and suffering have always been among the gravest problems confronted in human life. The man of the Old Testament lives his sickness in the presence of God. It is of God, Master of life and death, that he implores healing. Christ's compassion toward the sick and his many healings of every kind of infirmity are a resplendent sign that *"God has visited his people"* (Lk 7:16). Jesus has the power not only to heal, but also to forgive sins; he has come to heal the whole man, soul and body; he is the physician the sick have need of. His compassion toward all who suffer goes so far that he identifies himself with them: *"I was sick and you visited me"* (Mt 25:36). Moved by so much suffering Christ not only allows himself to be touched by the sick, but he makes their miseries his own: *"He took our infirmities and bore our diseases"* (Mt 8:17). On the cross Christ took upon himself the whole weight of evil and took away the *"sin of the world"* (John 1:29), of which illness is only a consequence.



"Heal the sick!" (Mat 10:8) The Church has received this charge from the Lord. As attested to by St. James: *"Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders*

[presbyters] of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven." (Jas 5:14-15) The Church believes and confesses that among the seven sacraments there is one especially intended to strengthen those who are being tried by illness, the Anointing of the Sick.

The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick has as its purpose the conferral of a special grace on the Christian experiencing the difficulties inherent in the condition of grave illness or old age.

The proper time for receiving this holy anointing has certainly arrived when the believer begins to be in danger of death because of illness or old age.

Sometimes we hear this sacrament to be called as *"last anointing"*, but the Anointing of the Sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Each time a Christian falls seriously ill, he may receive the Anointing of the Sick, and also when, after he has received it, the illness worsens. It is fitting to receive the Anointing of the Sick just prior to a serious operation. The same holds for the elderly whose frailty becomes more pronounced.

The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given on the forehead and hands (in the Roman rite) or also on other parts of the body (in the other rites) with duly blessed oil - pressed from olives or from other plants - saying, only once: *"Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up."*

Only priests (presbyters and bishops) can give the sacrament of the Anointing of

the Sick.

The faithful should encourage the sick to call for a priest to receive this sacrament.

This sacrament confers a special grace which unites the sick person more intimately to the Passion of Christ for his good and for the good of all the Church. It gives comfort, peace, courage, and even the forgiveness of sins if the sick person is not able to make a confession. Sometimes, if it is the will of God, this sacrament even brings about the restoration of physical health. In any case this Anointing prepares the sick person for the journey to the Father's House.

Viaticum

The Church offers those who are about to leave this life the Eucharist as viaticum.

The Lord says: "*He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day*" (Jn 6:54). The sacrament of Christ once dead and now risen, the Eucharist is here the sacrament of passing over from death to life, from this world to the Father.

Let us be grateful to the Lord that he bows down to us, as the Good Samaritan (Lk 10:30-37), that he is both the physician and the medicine for our illnesses, pain and difficulties. Let us pray for all those who are sick and suffering, so that in the Cross of Christ they find relief, encouragement and healing.

YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE SCHOL OF OUR LADY

Why do so many families get divorced in today's world? Why do so many children not even know their parents? Why are there are so many abortions in our families? Why are there so many problems in our relationships, especially in relationship between husband and wife?

Prayer groups usually meet in prayer every week. If possible, the meetings are held at church. Program of each meeting is simple, the prayer consists of rosary prayer, reflection on the Bible and messages of Our Lady, sharing, prayer for the intention of Our Lady, for the needs of the neighbors and consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Our Lady.
