“**D**ear children!

I, the mother of all of you gathered here and the mother of the entire world, am blessing you with a motherly blessing and call you to set out on the way of humility. That way leads to the coming to know the love of my Son. My Son is almighty, he is in everything. If you, my children, do not become cognizant of this, then darkness and blindness rule in your soul. Only humility can heal you. My children, I always lived humbly, courageously and in hope. I knew, I became cognizant that God is in us and we are in God. I am asking the same of you. I desire for all of you to be with me in eternity, because you are a part of me. I will help you on your way. My love will envelop you like a mantle and make of you apostles of my light – of God’s light. With the love that comes forth from humility you will bring light to where darkness and blindness rule. You will be bringing my Son who is the light of the world. I am always alongside your shepherds and I pray that they may always be an example of humility for you. Thank you.”

The apparitions of the Virgin Mary are a gift of God's mercy and love for man and the Virgin Mary confirms this in her message. Everything is a gift and grace from the Most High. From him comes all of the goodness

we receive. Medjugorje is a sign that God is faithful and does not only wait, but also looks for man. He does this from the beginning of creation, and especially after the first human fall into sin. The whole history of salvation is marked by God's seeking of man. These days God is calling us and is looking for us through Mary, her apparitions, messages and invitations.

Thirty-three years have passed during which Our Lady has been appearing in Medjugorje. Her motherly love remains unchanged. Her invitations are the same. She invites us to that which is the noblest, best and safest for us. She invites us to that which is eternal and that is God, whom she has met in a special way. That which Mary bears within herself, she wants to give away and bestow on us. She is full of grace and she gives an abundance of grace to us.

She, as the mother, leads us through that which she herself has passed. From the moment when God offered to her the motherhood



of his Son and when she said her fiat – be it done unto me – she began a pilgrimage on the narrow path that leads to life. The path of life of the Virgin Mary was filled with misunderstanding, persecution, exile and suffering. Yet she sings her *Magnificat* – My soul magnifies the Lord. We ask: how can someone say this, when life is only suffering and tribulation. She could, because God was her only goodness and a source of strength and life.

peace – says the Virgin Mary. That way of peace is not wide and comfortable but tight and narrow: nevertheless it leads to life. Prayer is a means which helps us to obtain peace on this path. God gives peace, it does not fall from the sky. Peace does not come spontaneously. There are conditions that must be met in order to obtain peace. A heart which is open and is ready to receive God's gifts is needed. The heart must be emptied, so that God can fill it. A human heart where hatred, revenge and evil of every kind dwell, is no place for God. God knocks on the door of our heart, but we cannot hear because of the sinful noise and thoughts that drown us.

Mary says: "Your heart and soul thirst for peace and love, for God and his joy." God wants to enter every heart by his grace and love through Mary. There is no human heart, which God does not desire and

which He is not looking for. The apostle John says: it is not that we loved God but that he loved us first. God always takes the initiative. He goes out first to meet man. And he also does it today through Mary.

Our heart unmistakably knows who is its author; who the Creator is. Therefore, we cannot deceive it with any other thing, honor or any human ephemeral success. Our heart, as Mary says, thirsts for the peace, love and joy of God. We can experience God's joy in our heart only through prayer. There is no other way. Whether we decide for prayer is a matter of life or spiritual death. Let us not be deaf to the invitation and prayer of the Queen of Peace through so many years, so that we obtain the wisdom of living and to learn to count our days – as the Psalmist says.


Let us pray:

IN PRAYER YOU WILL FIND THE WISDOM OF LIVING

On 25th June 2014, the 33rd anniversary of the apparitions, Mother Mary announced to us the joyful message – „*The Most High is giving me the grace that I can still be with you and to lead you in prayer towards the way of peace.*“ It is an enormous gift! Medjugorje is Mary's light. In her presence we find what we have lost – faith, hope, love, peace, the sense of life, the answer to our questions, the wisdom of how to live – and so we begin

to see. With each coming she embraces us with her motherly love, consoles us, encourages us, and shows us how to live this moment. To live her messages means to be on the way of peace.

In one of her most recent apparitions to the visionary Ivan, Mary said –“*Decide firmly to live my messages, so that I can give you new messages and guide you by them on the way of holiness. Therefore, may your decision today be yes – to live.*“ In today's message she invites us to live prayer. „*In prayer, you will find the wisdom of living*“ she says simply. This is an invitation to become wise, to recognise between good and evil, between right and wrong, to find God's will and not

to make decisions on our own in life, as well as during the events of each day. To pray means to become similar to the Lord. Jesus prayed all night to decide wisely. King Solomon was very young when he became king. He loved the Lord and also he obeyed the wise advice which his father David had given him. The Lord favored Solomon and one night spoke to him in a dream: “*What can I give you?*“ And Solomon replied: “*Lord, my God, I am too young and I cannot govern. So, give me wisdom, that I can govern your people in the right manner. Give to your servant an obedient heart to govern your people, to be able to recognize between good and evil.*“ And so the Lord gave him an obedient and humble heart.

In the epistle of the apostle St. James we read: “*If any of you lacks wisdom, ask*

God, who gives to all generously and unconditionally, and it will be given to you“ (Jas 1,5). In Mary's school we are invited to pray as she does, in her manner. In her messages she teaches: “*Let your life become prayer!*“ This means to pray and to live at the same time. Not just to pray in silence and on one's knees, but in each moment of life to be with Lord as she is. Mary is prayer and she is always with Jesus.

Let us learn from the gospel to behave like Mary. When the angel Gabriel came to her, she replied: „*Let it be done to me according to your word!*“ She knows how to respond and also when to be silent. For example, she doesn't explain to Joseph why she is

pregnant. She knows when to speak – at the wedding at Cana, when she tells her Son, „*They have no wine*“. Jesus is always with her and she keeps his wisdom in her heart and lives his words. Mary knows the sweetness of God's guiding wisdom in life.

When searching for wisdom in prayer, Mary encourages us to call on the Holy Spirit, to contemplate God's word, and to pray with the word of God.

Without prayer we are without wisdom – without Jesus. We could then liken our life to the gospel's parable of the house built on sand. To live with prayer means to build wisely – on rock. *“Therefore anyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, but it did not fall, because it was built on rock. But anyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice, is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; it collapsed, and what a terrible fall it was.”* (Mt 7, 24-27)

Today's invitation to us from Mother Mary is, with humbleness in prayer to ask for the gift of wisdom. Let us pray with Mary in our conversa-

tions, duties, decisions – that she might teach us how to live this present time with Jesus. She is interceding for us with her Son, to succeed.

Let us pray:

In your heart Mary, we bow before the Most High, thanking Him that he allows you to come to us. Teach us to pray with the heart. With you Mary, we pray „Holy Spirit, Spirit of wisdom, come, pray in us, we do not know how to pray as we ought.“ We pray also for those who do not pray and who make decisions on their own, without You, Jesus. We entrust to you all those who decide about the destiny of mankind at this time. We pray for them, that they also may receive the gift of the wisdom of how to live. Amen.

(December 25, 2000)



A blessing of peace and love

„Dear children! Today in a special way I bring the little Jesus to you, that He may bless you with His blessing of peace and love. Dear children, do not forget that this is a grace which many people neither understand nor accept. Therefore, you who have said that you are mine, and seek my help, give all of yourself. First of all, give your love and example in your families. You say that Christmas is a family feast. Therefore, dear children, put God in the first place in your families, so that He may give you peace and may protect you not only from war, but also in peace protect you from every satanic attack. When God is with you, you have everything. But when you do not want Him, then you are miserable and lost, and you do not know on whose side you are. Therefore, dear children, decide for God. Then you will get everything. Thank you for having responded to my call.“

Christmas is the time when we celebrate Mary's bringing Jesus who gives blessings of love and peace. In days of war, nothing is more needed than the blessing of peace and love. Peace is needed more than health, or family home, or freedom. To be without the blessing of peace and love means to be blind to that which we have, and to be unhappy in that which we have, and this is worse than not to have. There are so many people in the world who are healthy and have everything, but they have lost their peace and they are not able to love. They suffer much, destroying their life and the lives of others. The blessing of peace and love has its conditions, however. God must be in the first place, not only in individual hearts, but in families and in communities. When God takes the first place, then all hearts will experience the blessing of love and peace.

War is an awful thing. It is in the time of darkness that we understand better just how much we need the light! It is in the time of hatred that we understand that we need love. It is in the time of destruction that we come to understand how our life is passing and how the work of our hands is exposed to termination! War is also a time when we come to the realization of how much we need protection!

However, the time after war is not easy either. Hearts are in danger of remaining closed by hatred for a long time. The spirit of revenge can creep in. Sorrow and despair can overwhelm those who are left without

their dear ones. Satan wants to use this situation and deceive hearts for evil. However, those times when the war is far away are also not safe from these same attacks. True protection rests in our opening up to God and allowing God to protect us.

In this message, we again discover what is most important that Mary wants to teach us. God is everything to us. Without Him we are miserable and in darkness, unprotected and open to every destructive power, whether it comes from our own selves or from others. Mary calls us to decide for God, consciously and responsibly. This is the first step on the way to salvation. God took this step in Jesus. What remains is that each one of us gives an answer. To know on which side we are means to know the way through life and the purpose of life. God started to walk with us and all will be all right if we allow Him not only to sojourn with us, but also to lead us.

I give thanks to my God always on your account for the grace of God bestowed on you in Christ Jesus, that in Him you were enriched in every way, with all discourse and all knowledge, as the testimony to Christ was confirmed among you. So you are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revelation of Our Lord Jesus Christ. He will keep you firm to the end, irreproachable on the day of Our Lord Jesus. God is faithful and by Him you were called to fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ Our Lord. (1 Cor 1:4-9)

FOR FAMILIES, TO BE STRONG IN GOD...

“In the verse about a man leaving his father and mother and uniting to his wife (comp. Gn 2, 24), the Book of Genesis clarifies the conscious and free choice which brings about marriage, making a husband out of a son and a wife out of a daughter.” (Letter to families, 8)

People usually think that the unity of spouses is mainly about the physical union which is a condition for the fulfilment

to whom she obviously owes her motherhood.

Nevertheless, life experience shows that there are sometimes wrong relationships – when the marriage covenant is not respected, a result of which is that there are children who are socially half-orphans. A young mother often stays alone with children; a father leaves them and often starts a new family life. If an abandoned mother stays with a child

of marriage. They say that in marriage “consumatum est” is when this union took place. However, stories about marriage undoubtedly confirm that many times there was no union between the spouses, despite the fulfilment of the marriage by the sexual act. The body itself does not have the power to unify people.

Many times the bond between a husband and his mother is stronger than between him and his wife and then often, when it comes to family conflicts, the mother wins at the expense of the wife. Motherly love must be “ambitious”, including the willingness to leave, to sacrifice oneself. A child is not for the mother, but the mother is for the child – who leaves the home and enters into his or her own life. The mother does not promise love to her child but to her husband,

alone – especially if she has a son – the only child, she wraps him up in love, often egoistic love. She appropriates him and cares for him in a way that limits his freedom. At the same time, she binds him to herself in such a way that the son in his future married life subconsciously looks for everything he got from his mother, in his wife. And if he cannot find it, he accuses his wife of lack of love. An especially risky situation occurs soon after the birth of the first child. In the first months, a child requires more care from the mother than from the father, which is natural. The father is somehow not able to be a father and it seems to him that the wife does not care about him, so he often returns to his mother. And the mother who has been abandoned by her husband and who only has one child, this son, gives him all her tenderness

and affection. She often does it proprietarily and does not leave any room for the wife.

After the first birth, young parents who do not have their own flat often make this fundamental mistake. For example, the wife returns with a child to her mother because her mother can help her with child care and the husband returns to his mother because he believes that it will be easier for his wife – she will not need to cook for him, for example etc! After all, the mother will cook for her beloved son a delicious lunch which his young wife would never be able to cook. It is a relationship which leads directly to destruction. They did not leave the father and the mother and there was no real unity between them.

Unity cannot be formed spontaneously, automatically, just because they decided to get married and they unified physically. Unity is the fruit of the creative efforts of both of them. Free, wise people, decide that they will give themselves and their lives to one another and they will share everything together. It is not easy because it is a way of cleansing from egoism. And this requires not only the willingness to undergo it, but mercy too. That is why marriage is a sacrament, a covenant with God, whose mercy makes both of them able to unify. “Unity requires sacrifice too!”

DO NOT WORRY, I’M HERE.

I came to Medjugorje for the first time in 1990, when I was just 10 years old. I felt the presence of Our Lady in the depths of my heart. Although I did not know Croatian, it was not difficult for me to take part in everything that happens here. The prayer and pastoral work of the Franciscans and the special evening prayer program was a real school for me.

After the first pilgrimage to Medjugorje I decided to continue to pray as I had been praying in Medjugorje. I began to pray the rosary every day, to regularly attend holy mass and I started to pray for healing, just as it’s done in Medjugorje – especially on Fridays with veneration of the holy cross. As time went by, my desire to return there grew increasingly and I started coming every year, even during the war. Of course I was also scared, but I just could not be far away from Medjugorje. One evening Father Slavko said that we couldn’t go up the hill because there was a danger of bombing, but that evening he was the one who did go up. Then of course, many others followed him. As we went up I thought that I might die, but at the same time I heard a voice in my heart: “Do not worry, I’m here.” I knew it was the voice of Our Lady. Naturally, my fear disappeared.

Not only in that moment, that night, but for ever. Such were my beginnings in Medjugorje.

With each new trip to Medjugorje my experience of God and my prayer were deepened. During adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, I learned that prayer is a conversation with the living Jesus.

Deceased Father Slavko Barbaric is a real example for me. When I felt the invitation to priesthood, I freaked out, so I come back every year. Each time I entrust to Our Lady the year to come. I say to her: “Mother, help me!” She always truly helps me. Before I could start studying theology, I had to complete some studies and I had great difficulty. I came to Medjugorje and I said, “Our Lady, if you really want me to be a priest, help me to prepare for the seminary.” About a year later I returned to Medjugorje with excellent results from the exams at college that I had to pass, so that I could indeed enroll in theology. Our Lady gave me the strength to learn and cope with all the difficulties and I will be for ever grateful to her for that.

When in 1997 a website was launched, I was very pleased. Therefore, I asked Our Lady to teach me the Croatian language and slowly I managed to

learn it. What helped me a lot is that I always listened to programs on the radio station “Mir Medjugorje”.

Later I wanted to help Italy to hear about the beauty of Our Lady and also about the church, the sanctuary in Medjugorje and the nation. I started to translate homilies from Croatian into Italian because I thought it might be important, so that people and also priests



could understand. What is taught here in Medjugorje is neither strange nor new – it only proves that Jesus is alive. That is why at this place young people from all over the world have decided to follow Jesus and entrust their lives to Him. In Medjugorje we can say, “Jesus is alive”. And that’s all that Our Lady actually wants to say – that Jesus is alive.

In 2001 I was surfing the web and I found an Italian site: Information from Medjugorje. I immediately enrolled on their mailing list and I realized how many people there are who actually don’t know what is going on every day in Medjugorje. When they found out that I knew Croatian, they told me that I could translate. I felt it was a responsibility and a service to Our Lady and to Medjugorje that had given me so much. So I started to translate everything that I could find in Croatian. Over time, this mailing list began to grow more and more, and the group has grown. This service has really brought me joy. When I translate anything about Medjugorje, I feel as if I was right there, at the scene.

Before this mailing list, a group called “In love with Our Lady” was created, with the idea of establishing a prayer group over the internet. Every month we exchange ideas about Our Lady. Every evening at 9pm we unite in prayer. Over the internet we share prayer intentions and we regularly send our intentions to Medjugorje through the official website of the sanctuary. And sometimes we meet personally. During the Youth Festival in Medjugorje a few of us met and we had the opportunity to pray together and get to know each other.

Although I have since birth been in a wheelchair, I would say: “For God all things are possible.” In Medjugorje, Our Lady says that God is almighty, the Father who loves us. And for sure this experience of the boundless, unconditional love of God has helped me in my life in the struggle with physical dis-

abilities. I have experienced the profound experience of God’s love and faithfulness in Medjugorje, thanks to the intercession of Our Lady. Without Medjugorje I would definitely not be the man who I am today. I want to tell all young people who are disabled, that God is omnipotent. Do not be afraid of God and do not be angry at Him! He is waiting for you, He is giving you His hand, He wants to take you by the hand and make an example of you – a sign to the world. When you’re in trouble, just take the hand of His mother, Our Lady, to see and to experience that it really is just as she tells us in her messages that she is really our mother, that she is with us, she loves us and she intercedes for us.

God is great, Our Lady is great, she is our mother, the Queen of Peace, and she wants to help all of us. She desires that we all experience and feel His presence in our lives.

Our newspaper is published monthly since December, 2004. The new issue is sent via email a few days after the Virgin Mary gives Her message on each 25th day of the month. Voice Medjugorje is published in Russian, Ukrainian, Slovak, Lithuanian, Lithuanian, German and English language.

Through our newspaper we unite in prayer with our brothers and sisters from prayer groups mostly from the eastern countries – Russia, Ukraine, Lithuania, Latvia, Moldavia, Belorussia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, but also Pakistan, India, Slovakia, Czech Republic, USA, Germany, Austria.

Prayer groups usually meet in prayer every week. If possible, the meetings are held at church. Program of each meeting is simple, the prayer consists of rosary prayer, reflection on the Bible and messages of Our Lady, sharing, prayer for the intention of Our Lady, for the needs of the neighbors and consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Our Lady.

FIRST SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH

We usually meet in prayer on the first Saturday of each month. If possible, the prayer meetings are held on this day. We pray three rosaries, attend Holy Mass, Adoration and read reflections from the newspaper. We all pray for the intentions given in the newspaper, for the period of a whole month.

IN OUR LIVES WE ATTEMPT TO FOLLOW THE MESSAGES OF OUR LADY:

- to pray three rosaries a day
- to fast every Wednesday and Friday
- to confess monthly
- to attend Holy Masses, often receive Holy Communion and adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament
- to pray for the priests and Church
- to meet in prayer groups at least once a week, according to agreement of the members
- to help and serve our neighbours in a specific way
