REFLECTIONS ON THE MESSAGES FOR PRAYER GROUPS

BE JOYFUL CARRIERS OF PEACE

At the beginning of the apparitions Our Lady introduced herself to us by words: „I am your Mother and the Queen of Peace.“ She

appeared at Podbrdo exactly ten years before the cruel and bloody war in former Yugoslavia started. She wanted to strengthen the faith and encourage hearts of many people to what was about to happen in ten year's time. The war ended but not the "mission" of Our Lady – the Queen of Peace. She is the mother and therefore she cannot be quiet when watching us, her children. The war in former Yugoslavia is over but not the war and disorder in the world, families and hearts of many people; it still remains. Therefore Our Lady comes to us also today, talks to us, calls, invites and prays with us and for us.

Also in this message we find motherly words of our heavenly Mother who calls us to make a decision for peace. Word "peace" is the most frequently word used in her messages. And it is not used without reasons. We can see a lot of restlessness in the world. And restlessness comes from a man's heart that is filled by discontent.

Many times we tend to forget and that is why it is necessary to recollect some of the messages and calls of Our Lady in which she invites and calls us to peace."...*Dear children! You cannot have peace if your heart is not at peace with God. That is why, little children, pray, pray, pray, because prayer is the foundation of your peace...*" (June 25, 1997) „...*There is no peace, little children, where there is no prayer and there is no love, where there is no faith...*" (March 25. 1995) "*Dear children! Today I rejoice with you and I am praying with you for peace: peace in your hearts, peace in your families, peace in your desires, peace in the whole world...*"(December 25. 1994) "*Dear children! Today, I invite you to decide for God, because distance from God is the fruit of the lack of peace in your hearts. God is only peace. Therefore, approach Him through your personal prayer and then live peace in your hearts and in this way peace will flow from your hearts like a river into the whole world. Do not talk about peace, but make peace...*" (February 25. 1991) „...*Pray, because Satan wants to destroy my plans of peace...*" (December 25. 1990) „...*I have come here as the Queen of Peace and I desire to enrich you with my motherly peace. Dear children, I love you and I desire to bring all of you to the peace which only God gives and which enriches every heart. I invite you to become carriers and witnesses of my peace to this unpeaceful world. Let peace reign in the whole world which is without peace and longs for peace...*" (July 25. 1990) „...*I want each one of you to experience in your heart that peace which God gives...*" (June 25. 1987) „...*Little children, you are chosen to witness peace and joy. If there is no peace, pray and you will receive it. Through you and your prayer, little children, peace will begin to flow through the world. That is why, little children, pray,*



pray, pray, because prayer works miracles in human hearts and in the world....“ (October 25. 2001)

The messages of Our Lady are always new and genuine because they come from the motherly heart of Blessed Virgin. Her messages will never lose their significance, because they are essential for our spiritual life. We must acknowledge the fact that we cannot receive peace unless we strive for it. We must be prepared to pray at all times, deny ourselves, bring the sacrifice and die to ourselves every day. Christian life is a continuous effort and struggle not just empty speculations or philosophy. Our Lady wants to lead us and be with us on this way of hardship. And she still does that every day through her messages and apparitions.

She is the One who carried in her womb Jesus, the King of Peace and she wishes to bring Him also to us. She accepted God's peace into her heart and that is why she is bringing Him also to us. We also have to become those, who spread and bring peace to our neighbors. People living around us have a great need to see that to live in peace is possible even today. We need to become living evidence, witnesses for them by maintaining peace in our hearts.

St. Ambrose says: “Begin with the work of peace in yourself so that you, reconciled within you, could bring peace to others.”

We must acknowledge the fact that we cannot receive peace unless we strive for it.

We must be prepared to pray at all times, deny ourselves, bring the sacrifice and die to ourselves every day.

To have inner peace does not mean to create it by emotional effort within us. Peace is born in our hearts by presence of the One, who loves as – Jesus Christ. He is very dear and loving and he wants to give us His peace because He immensely loves us. He is capable to give us His peace also because he Himself suffered violence, hatred and death. This

is not peace that world, people or things can bring; Christ's peace comes from the cross by which he conquered sin, Satan and death.

Because Christ gave us this peace that lasts forever, it is our responsibility to live in peace with one another and with our neighbors. God gives us peace as a gift for us and it is also a call for us to seek His peace so that we could become instruments of His peace and bring it to our neighbors. Apostle Paul writes: “As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond

of peace. There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to one hope when you were called— one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. “ (Eph 4, 1-6)

Let us pray: *Blessed Virgin Mary, the Queen of Peace, with trust and humbleness we come to you, mother Mary, and ask you to pray with us and for us for peace in our hearts, families, the Church in the world. Our Lady, you have encouraged us when saying: “...Prayer works miracles in human hearts and in the world...” Mother Mary, we trust you because you experienced in your life God’s power and authority. Pray for us so that we could experience that everything is possible through Him. Our Lady, place our prayers and hearts before your Son Jesus Christ so that we could meet Him as our personal Savior who is the only source of peace for our hearts, the Church and this world. Amen.*

OCTOBER - THE ROSARY MONTH

"...And pray every day at least one Rosary: the joyful, sorrowful and glorious mysteries... " (August 14, 1984)

"...Especially, I call all those who have consecrated themselves to my Immaculate Heart to become an example to others. I call all priests and religious children, is especially dear to me. Through the rosary open your heart to me and I am able to help you... " (August 25, 1997)

Before his death, Padre Pio was asked as to what he would like to tell people. He said: "I would like to call every sinner in the world to love Our Lady; to pray Rosary. Satan attempts to destroy this prayer but he will never succeed. Because it is the prayer of Her who rules above every thing and every person. It is She who taught us to pray Rosary, just like Jesus taught us to pray Our Father. The word "rosary" comes from a latin word "rosarium", which means the bed of roses.

Every time we pray Rosary, we give Our Lady bouquet of roses - a chaplet of beautiful prayers that bring us by meditating closer to the mystery of our salvation. Praying Rosary is a very powerful means against evil that tries in every possible way to destroy souls of people. One, Pope Pius IX was given a question - what is the greatest treasure in Vatican. He replied by taking out the Rosary from his pocket and putting it above his head saying: "Behold! This is the greatest treasure of Vatican."



"...When you are tired and sick and you do not know the meaning of your life, take the Rosary and pray; pray until prayer becomes for you a joyful meeting with your Savior... " (April 25, 2001)

"...I invite you to call on everyone to pray the Rosary. With the rosary you shall overcome all the adversities which Satan is trying to inflict on the Catholic Church. All you priests, pray the Rosary! Dedicate your time to the Rosary!... " (June 25, 1985)

John Paul II. said: "Praying Rosary is an every day encounter where there are two present, Our Lady and I." He also encourages us: "If you wish to be for a very short moment close to the heart of Pope, I ask you to pray Rosary. In this prayer I give all of you to the hands Our Lady and I would be happy if you would by this prayer give yourselves to our Mother as well."



THE VISION OF TWO COLUMNS

Don Bosco's Prophecy

On 26 May 1962 Don Bosco promised to tell his boys and the young clerics he was training at his last month 'Good Night' talk a nice story. So it was on 30 May 1962 after an evening prayer. Before he started, he said: "I wish to tell you this for your personal spiritual growth. It is about a dream I had a few nights previously.

Try to picture yourselves with me on the seashore, or, better still, on an outlying cliff with no other land in sight. The vast expanse of water is covered with a formidable array of ships in battle formation, prows fitted with sharp spear-like beaks capable of breaking through any defense. All are heavily armed with cannons, incendiary bombs, and firearms of all sorts - even books - and are heading toward one stately ship, mightier than them all. As they try to close in, they try to ram it, set it afire, and cripple it as much as possible. This stately vessel is shielded by a flotilla escort. Winds and waves are with the enemy. In this midst of this endless sea, two solid columns, a short distance apart, soar high into the sky: one is surmounted by a statue of the Immaculate Virgin at whose feet a large inscription reads: Help of Christians "Auxilium Christianorum"; the other, far loftier and sturdier, supports a Host of proportionate size and bears beneath it the inscription Salvation of believers "Salus credentium".



The flagship commander - the Roman Pontiff - seeing the enemy's fury and his auxiliary ships very grave predicament, summons his captains to a conference. However, as they discuss their strategy, a furious storm breaks out and they must return to their ships. When the storm abates, the Pope again summons his captains as the flagship keeps on its course.

But the storm rages again. Standing at the helm, the Pope strains every muscle to steer his ship between the two columns from whose summits hang many anchors and strong hooks linked to chains.

The entire enemy fleet closes in to intercept and sink the flagship at all costs. They bombard it with everything they have: books and pamphlets, incendiary bombs, firearms, cannons. The battle rages ever more furious. Beaked prows ram the flagship again and again, but to no avail, as, unscathed and

undaunted, it keeps on its course. At times a formidable ram splinters a gaping hole into its hull, but, immediately, a breeze from the two columns instantly seals the gash.

Meanwhile, enemy cannons blow up, firearms and beaks fall to pieces, ships crack up and sink to the bottom. In blind fury the enemy takes to hand-to-hand combat, cursing and blaspheming.

Suddenly the Pope falls, seriously wounded. He is instantly helped up but, struck down a second time, dies. A shout of victory rises from the enemy and wild rejoicing sweeps their ships. But no sooner is the Pope dead than another takes his place. The captains of the auxiliary ships elected him so quickly that the news of the Pope's death coincides with that of his successor's election. The enemy's self-assurance wanes.

Breaking through all resistance, the new Pope steers his ship safely between the two columns and moors it to the two columns; first to the one surmounted by the Host, and then to the other, topped by the statue of the Virgin.

At this point something unexpected happens. The enemy ships panic and disperse, colliding with and scuttling each other. Some auxiliary ships which had gallantly fought alongside their flagship are the first to tie up at the two columns.

Many others, which had fearfully kept far away from the fight, stand still, cautiously waiting until the wrecked enemy ships vanish under the waves. Then, they too head for the two columns, tie up at the swinging hooks, and ride safe and tranquil beside their flagship. A great calm now covers the sea." At this point Don Bosco asked one of the boys present, Michael Rua - Don Bosco's first successor, for his views. He replied that he thought that the flagship symbolized the Church headed by the Pope, with the ships representing mankind and the sea as an image of the world. The ships defending the flagship he equated with the laity and the attackers with those trying to destroy the Church, while the two columns represented devotion to Mary and the Eucharist.

"Very well", replied Don Bosco, while adding that the enemy ships symbolized persecutions: "Very grave trials await the Church. What we have suffered so far is almost nothing compared to what is going to happen. The enemies of the Church are symbolized by the ships which strive their utmost to sink the flagship. Only two things can save us in such a grave hour: devotion to Mary and frequent Communion. Let us do our very best to use these two means and have others use them everywhere."

through your intercession will never be deceived by sin.



director of the Psychiatric Hospital Vrapče in Zagreb. From 1990 he has worked in the Psychiatry department of the Faculty of Medicine in Zagreb as an assistant from 1990 to 1998, and then as a senior lecturer from 1998 to 2004 and from 2004 as an associate professor of psychiatry at this faculty. He is a Professor of psychiatry at the Faculty of Medicine in Mostar and at the Faculty of Law Zagreb. He has been educated in marital and family psychotherapy. He has participated in a series of other educational programmes. He is a sub-specialist in social and forensic psychiatry. He is an active participant at many domestic and foreign expert gatherings.

He has published about 150 expert and scientific works, and is the editor of eight books. He is the head of numerous expert and scientific projects. He is a member of the editorial staff of two magazines, a member of a whole series of professional associations. He has worked and continues to work in many expert committees. He is an expert consultant of the Croatian Pension Insurance Institute. He is a court appointed expert witness. Often appears in the media in relation to subjects related to psychiatry. For his work he has been awarded multiple times, among others with the medal of the President of the Republic of Croatia.

The newspaper “**Voice Medjugorje**” is a call, invitation for everyone who wishes to pray for intentions of Queen of Peace and for realization of Her plans. By witnessing in our lives we long to become Mary’s Light to this world, to spread peace all around. On June 25, 2004 our Lady said: *“Dear children! Today also, joy is in my heart. I wish to thank you for making my plan possible to become reality. Each of you is important therefore, little children, pray and rejoice with me over every heart that has converted and become an instrument of peace in the world. Prayer groups are powerful, and through them I can see, little children, that the Holy Spirit is at work in the world. Thank you for having responded to my call.”*

Our small newspaper is published monthly since December, 2004. The new issue is sent via email a few days after the Virgin Mary gives Her message on each 25th day of the month. Voice Medjugorje is published in Russian, Slovak, Lithuanian, Lithuanian and English language. Through our newspaper we unite in prayer with our brothers and sisters from prayer groups mostly from the eastern countries – Russia, Ukraine, Lithuania, Latvia, Moldavia, Belorussia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Pakistan, Slovakia and Czech Republic.

Prayer groups meet according to the agreement made among the members, usually once a week, at their houses or at churches. Prayer meetings are conducted in modest and humble way and consist of praying rosary, meditation upon the text of the Bible and our Lady’s message, sharing after the meditation, praying for the prayer intentions of the Queen of Peace, praying for the needs of neighbors, consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

In our lives we attempt to follow the messages of Our Lady, which means:

- **to pray three rosaries a day**
- **to fast every Wednesday and Friday**
- **to confess monthly**
- **to attend Holy Masses, often receive Holy Communion and adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament**
- **to pray for the priests and Church**
- **to meet in prayer groups at least once a week, according to agreement of the members**

We usually meet in prayer **on the first Saturday of each month**. If possible, the prayer meetings are held on this day. At meetings, we pray three rosaries, attend Holy Mass, Adoration and read reflections from the newspaper. We all pray for the intentions given in the newspaper, for the period of a whole month.
