## MAY THIS TIME BE A TIME OF A PERSONAL PRAYER

While reading the Gospel I often find Jesus praying in private. By doing so Jesus has showed us how much he had needed a personal prayer and also the importance of such a prayer for every believer.

I am sure that besides these special moments which Jesus spent in the private prayer, as the Gospel reveals, He - the Christ was in a constant touch with His Father in the united prayer; Jesus also invites me to act just as he did - to pray often and even without ceasing. His followers, the apostles, teach us the same thing: "Pray continually!" (1 Thess 5:17)

Jesus is the unique example of a praying person. His personal prayer begins in the prayer of community, in a common prayer and at the same time, from a personal prayer grows a common prayer of the Church. In Gethsemane Jesus prays alone and at the same time

He prays together with his apostles. By celebrating Passover, together with the apostles He celebrates His Father, reads psalms and says prayers restricted by the Jewish law. He prays with his apostles in Gethsemane and asks them: "Stay here and keep watch with me .... Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation." (Mt

26:38.41)

In the latest message Our Lady turns our attention again to the need of solitude and seeking the encounter with

God in an intimate closeness, in which our understanding and acceptance of God's will are being improved in all its aspects. Personal contact with the Lord "expands" a human heart; creates inside increasingly more space for the Lord Himself and helps to be more open for the neighbor's needs. The fulfillment of the "space of a soul" by His love at the same time prepares us for the kind acceptance of our neighbors.

The Lord Himself lives within the community of praying souls and hearts, as He says: "For where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them." (Mt 18: 20).

Because a prayer in private forms my spirituality (it is the time when God transforms me and at the same time assures me of His love for me), He liberates me from my pride and strengthens my awareness of being his beloved child. Thanks to my friendship with Him I need to build up my common prayer, the prayer of the Church, where all of us can celebrate our Lord together.

Many times Our Lady has called us to a common prayer as well as to a personal prayer. Now again she turns our attention to the need of our personal touch with the Creator, so that we could once again cleanse the share of our own personality that belongs to the Lord.

The promising interconnection of a personal prayer with a common prayer gives us an assurance that from day to day we walk towards the Kingdom of God.

## DEAR FRIENDS OF THE QUEEN OF PEACE!

Also today we give thanks to our heavenly Father for the grace to listen to our Lady's encouraging message, in which She assures us: „I'm with you.“

Our heavenly Mother walks together with us, with the Church, nature and all creation. Also today She tells us: *“May this time be a time of personal prayer for you.”* Also in the message of January 25, 1999, Our Lady tells us: *“I again invite you to prayer. You have no excuse to work more because nature still lies in deep sleep. Open yourselves in prayer. Renew prayer in your families.”*

I recall a testimony of a lady from one Austrian prayer group. In this prayer group they use to open the book of the messages of Our Lady from Medjugorje and read one message for each person at a time. Afterwards they try to live this message in the following days. On one day the lady received the message of July 25, 1993, which says: *“Dear children, offer novenas, making sacrifices wherein you feel the most bound. I want your life to be bound to me.”* In the very same moment she knew that it meant her watching TV. This lady is retired and she used to watch soap operas every day. She decided to give up watching TV for following nine days and offer this sacrifice for Our Lady's intentions. The time she used to spend in front of TV she decided to spend in a nearby chapel of perpetual adoration before Jesus. At the time she was finishing her novena, they again had a prayer meeting. As usual they opened the book of the message of Our Lady and read the message for each one of them. On that night the lady received this message: *“Thank you for every sacrifice you have brought me. Dear children, live that way continuously, and with your love help me to present the sacrifice. God will reward you for that.”* (March 13, 1986). With gentle smile on her lips she said – how wisely Our Lady educates me. Since that time the lady instead of watching TV comes every day and adores Jesus in the Holy Sacra-

ment. And She serves the Lord with joy.

Our Lady really wants to lead out of her motherly heart each one of us. Also today she wisely points at what is for us the most important: make a good use of the winter time, when naturally there is more time for personal prayer. Respond with obedience to her invitation to personal prayer and be inventive and original when trying to spare the time for a prayer during the day. Therefore keep watch and together with the Lord build the foundation of the future events. Let us be faithful to a daily prayer of holy rosary, reading and meditation on God's word. Let us often come to Holy Mass and adore Jesus in the Eucharist.

In Psalm 127 we read: *“Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchmen stand guard in vain.”* Jesus was building the kingdom of heaven on His deep relationship with His Father. If we want that the seed of our faith would grow stronger and we “would move the mountains – that the Lord could through our prayers perform miracles,” we need to be in a deep and intimate relationship with Him.

We can learn from Bible, history of the Church and often from our own experiences that encounter with Jesus in depths of our hearts is a source of endless joy. Our Lady wants to bring us all to this encounter.

**Let us pray:** Mary, our dearest Mother, we trust you and completely surrender ourselves to you. Help us to persevere on the path of personal prayer so that we would grow in faith and joy.

25, 2002*



## „IN THE SCHOOL OF LOVE“

**Possible and Impossible**



**„Dear children! Today I call you to live the word this week: "I love God!" Dear children through love you will achieve everything and even what you think is impossible. God wants this parish to belong completely to Him. And that's what I want too. Thank you for having responded to my call.” (February 28, 1985)**

**L**ove is a grace and gift from God which can spread only if an individual accepts and cooperates with the grace. Love is a seed entrusted to a human, planted in his heart. The seed can grow only if there is cooperation, only if there is a daily feeding which can be used in every situation. To find good guidance and to implement the correct practice means to mature and become strong. The purpose is clear, love towards God. The way is simple and concrete. Take one day and practice living the words, “I love God!” There is no need to talk much about this exercise. The more we talk about the exercise and do not practice it, the more we will not have the results. Perhaps this is often the fate of God’s love and its seed which has been entrusted to us. We talk much about love, but practice it little. We know the

rules well, but we do not implement them! Let us now try to do so.

The first exercise is prayer. “O God, thank You for the love by which You love me!” After each invocation, remain a few moments in silence, repeating it in your heart. Repeat it every day until your heart begins to direct the prayers by itself. That means, if the mind forgets, then the heart forms the words by itself! Yes, the practice of prayer then becomes a deep part of our being and a necessity of the heart. If we forget to pray, we immediately begin to suffocate, just as we would suffocate if we forgot to breathe.

“God, today I wish to love You with all my life, with all my successes and my failures, in meeting with people and nature.

God, I love You in the members of my family, my community... (*mention names*).

God, I love You in those with whom I fight, whom I hate... (*mention names*).

God, I wish to love You constantly. Increase my love.

God, when I forget You, awaken in me and ardent desire to love You.

God, when my strength is at its end, grant that my heart may cry out and respond with love.

God, when my love falls short, help me to love You with the love of Mary, Your humble servant.

Mary, Mother of Love, pray for me every day, every week through my whole life.”

*Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.'... 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.' (Mt 25:34-36. 40)*

## GOD'S TEN COMMANDMENTS – 1.

**I am the Lord thy God and thou shalt not have any strange gods before me.**

*I am the Lord thy God...*

This revelation of loving God should again bring us to His arms. His Love overtops every other love. He desires that we would love Him and accept His love. In this truth of God's love we can think about the first commandment, its content and its specific meaning to our everyday life.


The first commandment embraces faith, hope and love (charity). Faith is the virtue by which we believe in God and disapprove everything that is against God. Hope is the confident expectation of divine blessing and the beatific vision of God. Love is virtue by which we love God above all for his own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God.

*...Thou shalt have no strange gods before Me. ...*

We shall worship only God and by doing so we shall recognize Him as our Creator, Saviour and the Lord. (Lk 4: 8) Our Lady teaches us to worship the living God when she praises and glorifies Him in the Magnificat for the great things He does for her and for His holy name.

We have been created in the image and likeness of God to be happy children of God with the heart full of God and His love, yet our hearts are restless until they rest in God – Love, as St. Augustine says. If we expel God and His love from our heart, it becomes empty. And we try to do everything to fill in this emptiness by a person or a thing. The door of our heart remain unlocked may we sometimes open it to the Thief, Killer and Destroyer, as the Word of God says in Jn 10: 10. Then instead of God's happy children we become slaves. Therefore the first commandment warns us against this danger by prohibiting us from: superstition, godlessness – disregard to God, pantheism and idolatry, magic and occultism.

Also the Catechism of Catholic Church reminds us: “All forms of divination are to be rejected: recourse to Satan or demons, conjuring up the dead or other practices falsely supposed to “unveil” the future (comp. Dt 18, 10; Jer 29: 8). Consulting horoscope, astrology, palm-reading, interpretation of omen and lots, seer craft and recourse to mediums, all conceal a desire for power over time, history, other human beings and at the same time a wish to conciliate hidden



powers. They contradict the honour, respect and loving fear that we owe to God.” (CCC 2116) By using these practices a man himself wants to decide what is good and what is bad; wants to have control over his life; to know what awaits him; but he forgets that by doing so he alone moves away from the beautiful plan that God has for him. A person forgets that he will not learn what the future hold for him from astrology. Keeping the right Christian attitude is in putting oneself confidently into the hands of Providence for whatever concerns the future, and giving up all unhealthy curiosity about it. (CCC 2115)

“All practices of magic and sorcery, by which one attempts to tame occult powers in order to place them at one's service and have a supernatural power over others – even if this were for the sake of restoring their health – they gravely contrary to the virtue of religion. These practices are even more to be condemned when accompanied by the intention of harming someone, or when they have recourse to the intervention of demons.” (CCC 2117) Among these practices we can also include the sins of idolatry and polytheism that divinize what is not God. For example, when a man honour and reveres creature in place of God, whether this be gods, demons, power, pleasure, race, ancestors, the state, money, etc. (CCC 2113)

Where faith and relationship with the Holy Trinity fades away, people turn to paganism and its practices. These practices are contrary to the Christian faith and worshiping of one God. In the book of Deuteronomy God says: “...I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the Lord your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him...” (Dt 30, 19-20)

### What should do a person who have been involved either deliberately or unconsciously with the evil one or lives in a family which is bound to the powers of darkness?

- to give himself completely to Jesus
- to do penance for what he has done, to confess, to forgive those who have harmed him or laid heavy burdens on his family line
- to renounce bad deeds he has done and the evil one who seduced him
- to cancel every curse and ask for forgiveness the people who have spoken them against him (in some cases curse or addiction has to be broken by other person – mostly by a priest)
- to have served Holy Masses with the intention for ancestors, for whom have not been served a Requiem Mass or who haven't had a Christian burial, for children that have been aborted; with the intention of cancelling the spiritual burden which have been passed on from one generation to another

## TESTIMONY „YES, I WILL FOLLOW YOU“



My name is Liga (26), I am the youngest of a three - children. My family used to live in a small village in Latvia. My parents were Catholic but they didn't really practice their faith.

When I was 7 and Latvia gained its independence, my family started to attend the Holy Mass on Sundays. I was very interested in religion; one year later I received the First Holy Communion and got involved in some activities for children in our parish. Little by little I became very attracted by the Church. Moreover, my elder sister started to study the theology and she told me many amazing stories about Jesus and lives of the saints.

As I grew up my childhood's enthusiasm diminished

and every Sunday Mass became like a heavy obligation for me. I didn't really understand what was happening during the Eucharist so I didn't really like it. The Church seemed to be just for elder people and I couldn't find my place there. Nevertheless I continued to pray and to believe in God.

After finishing Primary school I had to move to a nearby town and live in a dormitory so that I could study at Secondary school. As I didn't live with my family anymore, I was free enough to do what I wanted. At age of 16 I fell in some sort of depression due to several problems at school. I felt that in fact couldn't handle my problems myself anymore, I needed help but I was shy to speak about my inner feelings to my family. God remained my only hope. Every time I didn't feel well I just prayed - Lord Jesus, have a mercy on me! I don't know why I chose

exactly these words to pray - few years later when I discovered the prayer of Jesus, I was very surprised because this prayer helped me very much and I was healed from my gloom.

I prayed to the Lord for help but I didn't really expect that He would help me. When He answered my prayer I still had one more question - who is He? I loved Him very much in my childhood, I knew something about Him because I heard something about Him from others, but suddenly I experienced His presence - He really heard my cry.

During that time also some of my closest friends started to take interest in religion but they were rather attracted by other religions such as Buddhism and Hinduism. Discussing with them I gradually accepted that there was just one God and there was no difference how to name Him. Actually, I created my own religion - I took some pieces from different religions and mixed them together. I was deeply fascinated by esoteric literature. I prayed rosary and I prayed mantras, every morning I did some special ritual before going out and every evening I practiced transcendental meditation. Christianity wasn't priority for me anymore.

One evening I was meditating as usual and suddenly I felt as if something very big black fell on me. I got scared! I quickly stood up, switched on the lights, radio etc... Up till that moment I was sure that everything I was practicing was good. But after this experience I started to doubt. How can it be that during "prayer" you experience something negative? For some months I gave up the meditations but then I discovered in esoteric books that such an experience is absolutely normal for the beginners.

I finished the Secondary school. One week later the first Catholic youth days in Latvia took place and my sister invited me to join her. During these three days the Lord touched me very strongly. At first, I discovered that the Church was beautiful. There were so many young people singing and praising the Lord - and they looked so happy!

Also during these days father Rufus Pereira (vice-president of International Associations of exorcists) was present there. He was talking much about the danger of the syncretism and New Age practices. He explained that if we turn away from the Way and the Truth that is only Jesus, we open the door to demonical action. There were lots of questions in my mind; it wasn't easy for me to accept that I could be acting against the will of God. In the end father Rufus invited everyone to come closer to the altar and he prayed for each person. Before doing

that we had to forgive everyone who had ever offended us, to renounce every occult practice and to accept Jesus. I didn't really know what the word "occultism" meant but I felt that it somehow concerned me. Father Rufus prayed for me briefly and then I returned to my place. I don't know what happened during that short time of prayer, but was totally changed. The immense love, beauty and joy overflowed my heart - literally I was flying!

On my way back home my mood began to change. I realized that I was wrong in doing my religious practices; I realized that I had to renounce all of them in order to be a real Catholic but I felt something was blocking me. Thoughts that God doesn't love me invaded my mind and I felt completely broken.

Because it was a very hot day that day I decided to go swimming in the river. I was swimming and thinking about my experience of the youth days, I didn't know what to do and how to live further. As I was there alone (nobody was there) one thought pierced my mind - to give up everything - just two minutes and I would not exist anymore. It was up to me to make a final decision when I felt that I am not there alone ... Jesus was standing by the riverside waiting for me. He let me to choose life or death (Deuteronomy 30: 15-16). I ran out of the water as quickly as I could and promised Jesus - yes, I would follow You! As if a big stone was lifted from my heart and I was immediately fulfilled with joy again.

Afterwards I started to go to Church on regular basis, I joined the prayer group I am attending till today, I discovered the beauty and richness of the Catholic faith and all the treasures God proposes us.

Since that day I started to live a new life - the life together with Jesus and I am very happy! When we choose Jesus as our Lord and our Savior, if we choose to live according to His Word, it changes everything. Every day becomes a gift because our Heavenly Father is very generous to His children!

He loves us so much and His mercy is so great!

Through our newspaper **we unite** in prayer **with our brothers and sisters from prayer groups** mostly from the eastern countries – Russia, Ukraine, Lithuania, Latvia, Moldavia, Belorussia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, but also Pakistan, India, Slovakia, Czech Republic, USA, Germany.

**Prayer groups** meet according to the agreement made among the members, usually once a week, at their houses or at churches. Prayer meetings are conducted in modest and humble way and consist of praying rosary, meditation upon the text of the Bible and our Lady’s message, sharing after the meditation, praying for the prayer intentions of the Queen of Peace, praying for the needs of neighbors, consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.



**IN OUR LIVES WE ATTEMPT TO FOLLOW THE MESSAGES OF OUR LADY, WHICH MEANS:**

- to pray three rosaries a day
- to fast every Wednesday and Friday
- to confess monthly
- to attend Holy Masses, often receive Holy Communion and adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament
- to pray for the priests and Church
- to meet in prayer groups at least once a week, according to agreement of the members
- to help and serve our neighbour in a specific way

**We usually meet in prayer on the first Saturday of each month.** If possible, the prayer meetings are held on this day. At meetings, we pray three rosaries, attend Holy Mass, Adoration and read reflections from the newspaper. We all pray for the intentions given in the newspaper, for the period of a whole month.
